Key Legalization Updates

STATE-LEVEL LEGALIZATION

In 2024, the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA)
announced plans to reschedule cannabis from Schedule
I to Schedule III under the Controlled Substances
Act. This move represents a significant shift toward
federal acceptance, though the process

FEDERAL RESCHEDULING

 Recreational cannabis use is now legal in 24 states, while medical cannabis is permitted in 40 states.
Notably, Nebraska voters approved medical cannabis legalization in 2024, contrasting with Florida, North Dakota, and South Dakota, where recreational cannabis proposals were rejected

RECENT LEGALIZATION ACTIVITY


- Nebraska voted to remove possession penalties
- New Jersey and Arizona voters approved adult-use consumption
- Montana approved adult-use legislation
- Mississippi voters approved medical-use consumption
- South Dakota approved measures legalizing medical and adult use, considered to be an industry first


SAFE BANKING ACT


SECURE AND FAIR ENFORCEMENT BANKING ACT

- Creates protections for banks that provide financial services to legitimate cannabis businesses; broad bipartisan support in the House
- Bill passed U.S. House of Representatives in 2019

While cannabis is still illegal federally, access is widespread and there continues to be significant momentum for additional medical and adult-use legalization.




